Crafts and Commercial Street Faire

Saturday & Sunday, June 5 & 6, 2010

Crafts Faire, handmade crafts only, entry fee \$225.00. **Commercial or Buy & Sell Faire** entry fee is \$325.00. Vendor fees include City of Patterson Business License fees. Spaces are 12' x 12' in groups of four. Most everyone will be assigned a corner space. There is a major publicity campaign promoting the event, with approximately 30,000 people expected in Patterson that weekend.

Applicants must send 3 colored photos of the products to be sold along with the City of Patterson Business forms, Craft/Commercial application and entry fees. **(Only Cashier's Checks, Money Orders or Visa/MC are accepted methods of payment. No personal checks, please.)** Please make payment to the **Patterson Apricot Fiesta** and mail to **Patterson Apricot Fiesta, P.O. Box 442, Patterson, CA 95363** by April 1, 2010 to reserve your space. Failure to do so will delay your placement in the Craft/Commercial Faire. **Applications mailed after April 1, 2010 will be assessed a \$25.00 late placement fee.**

Set up time is 7:00 to 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 5, 2010.

Rules of the Craft/Commercial Faire

1. All persons are responsible for their own sales tax.
2. Payment of space fees is due with application forms, no personal checks, please.
Money Orders, Cashier's Checks and Visa/Master Card ONLY.
3. Area around space must be left clean and free of all paper and trash.
4. Liability insurance is the responsibility of the vendor.
5. No cars or trucks will be allowed on the streets after booths are set up.
6. All vendors will receive a vehicle pass to enter the area for the purpose of setting up and disassembling their booth.
7. Spaces measure 12' x 12' (most with a corner)
8. HOURS: SATURDAY 10:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m., and SUNDAY, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
NO TRANSACTIONS will be allowed after closing time.
9. No alcoholic beverages allowed in booths at any time by vendors. All vendors must conduct themselves in a professional manner. Any vendors not complying with the Rules/Regulations of the Patterson Apricot Fiesta, Inc. and the laws and ordinances of the City of Patterson may be asked to close and risk future participation in Patterson Apricot Fiestas.
10. If you decide to close early, you will **NOT** be allowed to bring in any vehicles until official closure times.
11. There are **NO DOGS/ANIMALS** allowed at the show or in the downtown areas.
SEEING EYE DOGS or SERVICE DOGS ONLY.
12. No electricity will be available. If you use a generator you **MUST** mark it on your application or you will not be allowed to use it.
13. The Patterson Apricot Fiesta is **NOT** responsible for damages, losses or inclement weather.
