## Parade Rules

- All entries must be received by May 28, 2010. Any cancellations or withdrawals after this date will not be refunded. Any entries received after this date may not be in the line-up, it is possible to be in the parade, however it may be at the end.
- CHECK-IN TABLE will be located on the corner of West Las Palmas Avenue and 9<sup>th</sup> Street. Check-in on parade day starts at 7:30 a.m. All entries are to be checked in no later than 9:30 a.m. Any entries not checked-in on-time may be relocated in the line-up to the end of the parade.
- PARADE ASSEMBLY time is 9:30 a.m. sharp. Failure to be in position by 9:45 a.m. may result in a reassignment in the line up.
- SAFETY FIRST- For the safety of both participants and spectator:
  - No objects are to be thrown, sprayed, or discharged in any way or at any time along the parade route.
  - No loaded weapons or discharging of firearms will be allowed
  - No use of fire, fireworks or other pyrotechnics will be allowed
  - No alcoholic beverage of any type will be allowed.
  - No tobacco or related products will be allowed
  - All living things on a moving entry must be secured
  - No one is allowed to ride on the running boards, roofs or fenders.
  - Entries utilizing martial arts or gymnastics (including cheer stunts) must use appropriate protective gear and trained adult "spotters"
  - Entries with live animals must maintain control of them at all times.
- FORWARD MOTION PARADE, Each Entry must maintain general forward motion throughout the entire Parade Route, with at least one member of the unit maintaining a forward movement at all times. Failure to maintain forward motion at all time throughout the Parade Route may result in being disqualified.
- PARADE ROUTE must be completed by all units. Failure to comply will result in disqualification. Delays in parade route will be penalized. A parade marshal will be at the end of the parade route to check off your entry.
- FIFTY (50) feet spacing is required between units. This is for safety.
- POLITICAL ENTRIES- Candidate must be present in person with/on entry through entire parade route or their fee will be doubled.
- PERFORMANCES- All entries must perform throughout the entire Parade Route, while maintaining a forward motion.
- KIDS GROUP PRIZES- there is a special individual ribbon for each child in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners. There is a limit of 50 ribbons per winning entry.
- CAR CLUBS there is a maximum of 15 vehicles per car club, or result in disqualification.
- All vehicle drivers must have clear unobstructed visibility and hold a valid Drivers License. All tires must remain in contact with the pavement at all times. All drivers must obey the California Vehicle Code.
- NO ENTRY may enter the parade route more than one time for competition regardless of changes in name or appearance.
- No type of abusive language or signs will be allowed.
- UNITS with sound or unusual noise must so indicate on entry form. Failure will result in penalty in competition.
- \*\*Fees- If your entry form is submitted before May 14<sup>th</sup> there is a \$10 discount, pay only \$10. From May 15-24 pay regular fee of \$20. After May 25<sup>th</sup> entries will be considered as "Day of" with a fee of \$40. Please get your entries in early.
- All prize money will be mailed to the address listed on the entry form for winning entries.
- The parade committee reserves the right of final decision on entries. The committee reserves the right to bar from the parade, at any time, any entry not conforming to these rules and regulations, or refusing to follow instructions of law enforcement or parade officials.
